A Few Quick Notes about being in Shrek:

SHOW DATES ARE APRIL 21-23. IF Prom presents a conflict, we may consider not having a show that Saturday night. That will TBA depending on how many it affects.

Most Leads and featured characters will start rehearsals right away. The younger ensembles will most likely start rehearsals later this month.

If you are cast in a lead role, the main days to plan for are Wednesdays, Fridays, Saturdays and Sundays. We can accept some conflicts but please note, the number of conflicts can affect the size of the role you are cast in.

There are many featured characters and lots of speaking/singing opportunities in this show. There are also roles for dancing mice (tap dancers) and dancers that perform in other numbers like "Welcome to Duloc" Younger children may be cast as fairytale characters, mice or other animals.

Auditions will begin this Sunday. There are TWO options for auditioning for 6th grade and up.

If you wish to be considered for an individual role, see below for what to prepare for. If you only wish to be considered for a dance role (and not an individual speaking/singing role) you can attend group only auditions on Wednesday.
